Mother's Day week we broke ground on a new facility right next door to The Pregnancy Center. This location, Laurie's Place, is in collaboration with Mom's House. It is affectionately named after a woman who left a legacy that every life had value, regardless of their circumstances. She also believed that an open door and a full table could heal hearts, families, and communities.

I believe that Northwest Ohio can be the best place for moms and dads to raise their babies. I believe that life can and should be irresistible. Laurie's Place will house Mom's House of Toledo's second location, providing free childcare for single moms who are completing any level of their education by providing incredible education for these kiddos, and life-changing programs for the moms and dads.

On the second floor, the Bella Vita Network offices will be relocated to make room for expanded medical services at The Pregnancy Center. Additionally, there will be expanded space for our pregnancy and parenting classes, including a 100-person meeting room.

And the Together Space—'to-get-her' (get it?!)—aims to get 'her' to stability and help 'her' achieve her dreams. We are currently in the process of establishing partnerships with 27 community organizations to offer rotating office hours, thus reducing barriers for moms and dads as they start or grow their family. We are thankful to Jobs and Family Services, the Toledo Zoo, CJ Thomas Mental Health, Brothers United, and Mercy Health for their commitment to this space already.

I look forward to growing this collaborative space together.
This is what making life irresistible looks like. Thanks to this community for stepping up in faith, support, and generosity.


